DINOLFO: AIRSHOW WILL RETURN TO ROC IN 2019 UNITED STATES AIR FORCE THUNDERBIRDS TO APPEAR

Monroe County Executive **Cheryl Dinolfo** today announced that the United States Air Force Thunderbirds and their F-16 Fighting Falcons will take to the skies at the Greater Rochester International Airport (ROC), Saturday, August 24th & Sunday, August 25th for a 2019 Airshow.

"We are honored to have the opportunity to welcome the Thunderbirds back to Monroe County to headline another exciting airshow," said **Dinolfo**. "Our airshow is always a popular, family-friendly event that offers fun for all ages while saluting our military's strength and excellence. We look forward to again offering a spectacular lineup of aerial performances and unique displays for all to enjoy in the summer of 2019."

Each year the Department of Defense receives hundreds of requests to hold airshows. ROC was selected by the Thunderbirds at the recently held International Council of Airshows (ICAS) where the team released its two-year schedule earlier today.

The Thunderbirds were the featured act at the ROC airshow in 2005, 2008 and 2014. This will be the fourth time in the last fourteen years, ROC has been fortunate to host the Thunderbirds. The Thunderbirds are the official air demonstration team of the United States Air Force and are stationed at Nellis Air Force Base in Nevada.
