DINOLFO APPOINTS MOORE AS PERMANENT AIRPORT DIRECTOR

Moore has served as Interim Director since October 2017

County Executive **Cheryl Dinolfo** today announced the appointment of **Andrew Moore** as permanent Director of the Greater Rochester International Airport. **Moore** has served as Interim Airport Director since October 2017.

*"I am thrilled to announce that Andy Moore will continue to pilot our Airport well into the future with his steady leadership and unprecedented understanding of local aviation," said **Dinolfo**. "Andy did an incredible job of bringing our transformational Airport renovation project to fruition, all while managing day to day airport operations with minimal impact on local travelers during construction. I'm confident that Andy's experience and expertise will help our Airport continue to attract more visitors, more jobs, and more investment to Monroe County moving forward."*

Prior to serving as Interim Director, **Moore** held the position of Deputy Airport Director for 4 years. In the last year, he oversaw successful completion of the \$79 million Upstate Airport Economic Development and Revitalization Project at ROC, or ROC Renovation.

In addition to overseeing day-to-day operations at the Airport, **Moore** will oversee enhanced air service development efforts to attract new flights and expanded seat capacity for destinations out of ROC.

Moore is a certified member of the American Association of Airport Executives (AAAE) and has earned industry certification from Airport Council International (ACI) in areas of Concession Management and Airport Security. He is an active participant of the New York Aviation Administration (NYAMA) Legislative Advocacy Day and current serves as NYAMA Treasurer. He replaces former Airport Director Michael Giardino, who took a new position in Virginia in October 2017.

In his personal life, **Moore**, his wife Nicole and their two children reside in the Town of Penfield, where he has served as Town Councilman for the past ten years. He enjoys coaching Little League Baseball and as a former Eagle Scout continues to volunteer with the Boy Scouts of America.
