Monroe County Executive **Cheryl Dinolfo**, will join representatives from Lifetime Assistance, Inc. **Tomorrow, June 9**th **at 8:15 a.m.** to kick off the 19th Annual Lifetime Assistance Airport Games at US Airports Flight Facility Hangar at the Greater Rochester International Airport (ROC).

"For the past 19 years, we have hosted this fun family event which not only promotes health and fitness, but incredibly has raised over \$1,000,000 thanks to our caring and charitable community."

The Airport Games is a family-friendly event that offers a variety of activities for attendees to enjoy. Attractions include static aircraft displays lining the course from the Civil Air Patrol and Rochester Air Center. The Flower City CrossFit 5K includes five stations throughout the 5K course that participants must complete along the way to test their endurance and strength. The event also features youth passport games, including a "Fun Run" for children under the age of 12 years. The Gates Fire Department is also hosting a fire truck pull. Participants in this event partner with ten teammates to pull the 90,000 lb. fire truck for fifteen seconds. The team that pulls the fire truck farthest wins!
