DINOLFO ANNOUNCES EXPANDED NON-STOP TAMPA SERVICE ON SOUTHWEST DURING NOVEMBER

Daily, Non-Stop Service Sunday through Friday beginning November 3rd

Monroe County Executive **Cheryl Dinolfo** today announced that Southwest Airlines has added non-stop flights to Tampa (TPA), Florida six days per week, Sunday through Friday beginning November 3rd from the Greater Rochester International Airport (ROC).

*“This announcement from Southwest is more great news for our new-and-improved airport,” said **Dinolfo**. “Tampa is a popular market for local travelers and these direct flights, offered six days a week during the month of November, will provide even more affordable, convenient options for those looking to enjoy the Florida sun and surf this fall.”*

Southwest will be using their 737-700 aircraft for the non-stop service from ROC to Tampa (TPA).

This non-stop service announcement was on the heels of Southwest’s recently released schedule announcing Saturday non-stop service to Ft. Lauderdale (FLL) and Ft. Myers (RSW) along with Saturday and Sunday non-stop service Tampa (TPA) in January and February 2020. Southwest also offers daily non-stop service to Orlando (MCO) increasing to two non-stop flights on Sundays in January and February 2020.

Passengers can begin booking tickets today online at www.southwest.com. Strong passenger support of these non-stop flights demonstrate that our community can support additional non-stop service in the future.
