AIRPORT REMINDS HOLIDAY TRAVELERS TO ARRIVE EARLY

For the upcoming holiday travel period, the Greater Rochester International Airport (ROC) reminds passengers to arrive at the terminal early and offers the following travel tips:

- Arrive at the airport **at least 90 minutes** ahead of the scheduled departure time. Especially those with early morning flights between 4:30 a.m. and 8:00 a.m. when 15 flights depart ROC.
- Have a parking plan. ROC offers many on-site parking options. Visit www.rocairport.com and use the parking calculator tool for budgeting.
- Contact the airline prior to travel to check flight information and verify baggage restrictions.
- Have your government-issued photo ID and boarding pass ready.
- Consolidate and minimize luggage when possible.
- Visit the Transportation Security Administration's website at www.tsa.gov for a complete list of permitted and prohibited items in carry-on and checked luggage, information on how to pack holiday gifts, TSA Pre[✓]™ information and more.
- Reminder to family and friends picking up arriving passengers this holiday season to use the Smart Phone Lot for staging to reduce vehicle congestion on terminal roadways. Arriving passengers may identify the column number they require pick up at - after they have retrieved their baggage from the claim.
