NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR PUBLIC COMMENT RELATED TO PASSENGER FACILITY CHARGE PROGRAM

The Frederick Douglass-Greater Rochester International Airport (ROC) is providing an opportunity for public comment until April 27, 2023 related to the proposed amendment to our Passenger Facility Charge (PFC) Application #4.

Monroe County received approval from the FAA to “impose and use” PFCs for two projects at the Frederick Douglass-Greater Rochester International Airport on July 11, 2006. The approved collection amount for these projects was \$36,932,278.00. This PFC Application #4 is the subject of a proposed amendment prior to closeout.

Monroe County is proposing to decrease the total amount of PFCs to be collected on these projects from the current approved amount of \$36,932,278.00 to \$29,377,645.19. Both projects in this application are now complete. The Airport chose to fund project 04-001 Terminal Renovations with “Pay-As-You-Go” PFCs with no debt financing & interest funding used as originally approved. PFC funds collected in excess of the amount required will be used on other approved PFC projects in subsequent PFC applications.

Due to the change in the PFC method of funding, from debt financing to “Pay-As-You-Go”, the FAA requires Monroe County to seek public comment on the above-mentioned changes to this PFC Application.
